WORKSHOP 2: THE PSYCHODYNAMIC FORMULATION – A CONTEMPORARY APPROACH (CENTRAL BALLROOM B)

This workshop will be conducted by faculty from the University of the Philippines Department of Psychiatry and the Chair of the Education in Psychiatry Section of the WPA. It will include video clips, brief lectures, interactive exercises and a research component on site to measure the impact of the pedagogical intervention.
